


Fostering Resilience: Raising Children and Adolescents Who Are Prepared to Thrive is an overview of the Seven C's Model of Resilience focused on communication strategies that position parents to be unwavering positive forces in their children's lives. Attention is placed on strategies that parents can use to help their children help themselves.

Authentic Success: Raising Adolescents in a Challenging World discusses how to foster high achievement in children while instilling a love of learning, rather than a fear of failure. The college admissions process will be discussed, and the importance of guiding each child to find the right educational match will be emphasized. This seminar is about raising successful children who will make their unique and substantial contributions to the world.



Dr. Ken Ginsburg is a pediatrician specializing in Adolescent Medicine at The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia and a Professor of Pediatrics at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine.

He also serves as Director of Health Services at Covenant House Pennsylvania, an agency that serves Philadelphia's homeless and marginalized youth.

In Dr. Ginsburg's adolescent medicine practice, he cares for a wide variety of medical conditions, while simultaneously addressing adolescent behavioral issues. He practices social adolescent medicine -- medicine with special attention to prevention and the recognition that social context and stressors affect both physical and emotional health.
